ACT OF FAITH

O my God, I firmly believe that Thou art one God in three Divine Persons, + Father, Son and Holy Ghost; I believe that Thy Divine Son became Man, and died for our sins, and that He will come to judge the living and the dead. EPISTLE (Sit)

Reader: Lesson from the Epistle of Blessed Apostle... to the ...or from the Acts of the Apostles.. or from the Book of Wisdom... or from the Prophet...

At the end of the reading, all respond: Deo Gratias! (Thanks be to God).

GOSPEL (Stand)

Reader: The continuation of the Holy Gospel according to... Gloria tibi Domine.

After the reading, respond: Laus tibi Christe. (Praise be to thee, O Christ.)

(Explanations to Epistle & Gospel)

THE CREDO

I believe in one God, the Father Almighty, maker of heaven and earth, and of all things visible and invisible. And in one Lord Jesus Christ, the only – begotten Son of God. Born of the Father before all ages. God of God, light of light, true God of true God. Begotten, not made, being of one substance with the Father; by whom all things were made. Who for us men and for our salvation came down from heaven (kneel) and was
INCARNATE BY THE HOLY GHOST OF THE VIRGIN MARY;
and was made man.

He was crucified also for us; suffered under Pontius Pilate, and was buried. On the third day He rose again according to the Scriptures. And He ascended into heaven; He sitteth at the right hand of the Father. And He shall come again with glory to judge both the living and the dead; of whose kingdom there shall be no end. And I believe in the Holy Ghost, the Lord and Giver of life; Who proceedeth from the Father and the Son, Who together with the Father and the Son is adored and glorified, who spoke by the prophets. And in one holy Catholic and Apostolic Church. I confess one baptism for the remission of sins. And I look for the resurrection of the dead.

Last Gospel:

V/ The beginning of the holy + Gospel according to St. John.

R/ Glory be to you, O Lord.

In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. The same was in the beginning with God. All things were made by Him, and without Him was made nothing that was made. In Him was life, and the life was the light of men: and the light shineth in darkness, and the darkness did not comprehend it.

There was a man sent from God, whose name was John. This man came for a witness, to bear witness of the light, that all men through Him might believe. He was not the light, but was to bear witness of the light.

That was the true light, which enlighteneth every man that cometh into this world. He was in the world, and the world was made by Him, and the world knew Him not. He came unto His own, and His own received Him not.

But as many as received Him, to them gave He power to become the sons of God: to them that believe in His name; who were born, not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of men, but of God. (Here all kneel)

AND THE WORD WAS MADE FLESH, and dwelt among us; and we saw His glory, the glory as of the only-begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth.
